

2023 AIA FORT WAYNE DESIGN AWARDS – Call for Entries

All AIA Fort Wayne member architects in good standing who have led the design of completed projects inside or outside of Indiana are invited to compete for Honor, Merit, and Citation Design Awards.

PROCESS

Categories

The jury will be requested to review submissions for possible awards in the following areas:

- 1. NEW CONSTRUCTION (Project cost greater than \$5 million)
- 2. NEW CONSTRUCTION (Project cost less than \$5 million)
- 3. PRESERVATION/ADAPTIVE REUSE/RENOVATION
- 4. INTERIOR ARCHITECTURE (Project cost greater than \$5 million)
- 5. INTERIOR ARCHITECTURE (Project cost less than \$5 million)
- 6. NON-TRADITIONAL PROJECTS

<u>New Construction, Preservation/Adaptive Reuse/Renovation, or Interiors</u>: All entries for New Construction, Preservation/Adaptive Reuse/Renovation, or Interiors must be a constructed work of architecture, either a building or a complex of buildings and related spaces.

<u>Non-Traditional Projects:</u> This category is intended to recognize any creative work not applicable for the remaining categories (e.g., research & development, regional & urban design, art installations, unbuilt, etc.).

Eligibility and Authorship

All AIA Fort Wayne member architects who have led the design of completed projects are eligible to submit project entries. Where multiple architects and/or designers collaborated on respective projects, the applicant shall identify all participating design and engineering firms and their roles in the project.

Entries are welcomed and encouraged from both established and new practitioners and designers and from small firms and large. All submissions must have a substantial completion date within five (5) years of the submission date.

An individual or firm may submit more than one entry. It is recommended the architect inform the owner that the project has been entered in this awards program. An additional entry fee is required if a submission is entered into more than one category. Entries submitted to previous AIA Fort Wayne Awards Programs may be resubmitted if they did not receive an award.

Adjudication

Entries will be judged by the 2023 AIA Fort Wayne Design Awards Jury, which will be an eminent architectural jury of peers from the AIA Prairie Illinois Chapter.

It is the intention of AIA Fort Wayne to publish jury members and their respective comments regarding the award recipients at the time of the presentation of the awards. Comments on entries that do not receive an award are typically not provided.

All decisions of this jury are final and independent from AIA Fort Wayne, its officers, directors, committee members, and staff. The AIA Fort Wayne Awards Director does not participate in the jury deliberations but will facilitate preparation and presentation of the awards.

Recognition

Jurors of previous AIA Fort Wayne award programs have traditionally recognized three classifications of awards:

- Honor
- Merit
- Citation

Awards have been given in each category, but it is the liberty of the jury to present awards as they rule appropriate.

Presentation of Awards

Results of the jury and award winners will remain undisclosed to the public until the day of the presentation. Media releases may be released the day prior to attract media promotions. Winners will receive a plaque.

The awards will be presented at the annual awards ceremony and holiday party in December. All entrants are encouraged to attend the awards ceremony. Owners of the built work and contractors are also encouraged to attend.

PROVISIONS

Payment

Registration fees for AIA Fort Wayne members/firms are \$150.00 for the first entry and \$75.00 for each additional entry thereafter. Fees are non-refundable and will not be refunded for entries that are disqualified or that do not receive an award. Collected fees will cover expenses for publication of the program to the membership, jury expenses, production of the awards, and promotion of the awards to the public.

Submission Format

Submission Deadline

Submission deadline is **4 p.m. EDT, November 3, 2023**. Entries received after the deadline will be disqualified without consideration.

Required Material

As applicants prepare their applications, entries are encouraged to be concise. Specific attention should be given to telling a compelling story of project's scope, challenges, solutions, and personality. Each PDF application must include the following:

- Submission Category
- Project Type (Specify Use of Building)
- Project Cost
- Project Address
- Date of Substantial Completion
- Photos
- Architect's statement concerning design considerations, limitations, requirements, and solutions. Type of construction indicating materials, mechanical and electrical systems, energy efficiency, and other pertinent technical information. Special considerations such as accessibility, sustainable design, etc., and how these factors impacted the design of the project.
- No distinguishing marks, symbols, trademarks or icons should be visible on any part of the submission.
- Please name this file <u>yourprojectname</u>-submission.pdf. Please limit your submission to no more than <u>20 PDF pages</u>. No file shall be larger than <u>30 megabytes</u>.

In a separate file, applicants must include a document (PDF) to outline the following:

- Project Name (As it should appear on the Award)
- Project Address
- Architect and Firm Name and Address (Specify individual(s) or firm name or both as it should appear on the Award)

- Owner's and/or Developer's Name and Address
- Consultant's Names and Addresses for Civil, Structural, Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Landscape Architecture, Etc.
- General Contractor's Name and Address
- Multiple Prime or Sub Contractor's Names and Addresses
- Photographer's Name and Address (be certain to identify photographer of each photograph as required by copyright where applicable)
- Typed Name and Signature of the submitting architect authorizing AIA Indiana to reproduce portions of the entry materials for promotional purposes.
- Project/Entry authorship will remain concealed from the jury during all deliberations.
- Please name this file *yourprojectname*-informationsheet.pdf.

Submitted material will be used by AIA Fort Wayne in promotion of this program, and for publicizing the winning entries.
